- Scrubs are acceptable on your call days. Do not wear your scrub masks, hats, or shoe covers outside of the operating room or labor and delivery.
- Ties are highly recommended for men.
- Wear your name tag/ID at all times, even on scrub suits in the OR and Labor and Delivery.
- Wear your Clean white coat especially in clinic and on rounds over your scrubs, though you are encouraged to dress up.
